On August 5, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Notice of Opportunity to File Written Comments to propose metrics by September 6, 2022. On September 9, 2022, the Commission issued a Notice Clarifying it August 5, 2022, Notice of Opportunity to File Comments. The clarification indicated that the Commission does not envision including specific calculation methods for metrics in the policy statement it issues at end of Phase 1, and that the Commission will provide additional opportunities to for parties to propose and respond to the specific calculations in a later process.
