Dear Mr. Johnson:

On December 28, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Approving Application Subject to Conditions in the above-referenced docket. Order 01, among other things, required Northwest Natural Gas Company (Northwest Natural or the Company) to provide annual customer credits.¹

On September 12, 2019, Northwest Natural filed revised tariff schedule 209 proposing updated customer credit rates. On September 27, 2019, the Company filed a revised tariff page correcting the marginal notes. The Company's revised tariff schedule provides the required customer credits and is to become effective on November 1, 2019.

Commission Staff (Staff) reviewed the compliance filing provided by Northwest Natural dated September 12, 2019, and revised on September 27, 2019, and finds that it contains sufficient detail with respect to customer credits. Therefore, Staff believes that the filing complies with the Commission's Order 01, entered December 28, 2017.

¹ 35. For a period of three years following the formation of HoldCo, NWN-U will provide an annual credit to Washington customers in the amount of \$55,000 on an equal percent margin basis concurrent with NWN-U's PGA.
