As you may know, a bill passed the Washington State Legislature (SB 5939) that was recently signed into law by the governor.

This legislation created a new incentive program for electric utilities serving customers in the state of Washington intended to promote a sustainable, local, renewable energy industry. For your reference, a summary of this legislation is enclosed.

The WSU Energy Program will administer the new incentive program beginning October 1, 2017. Until then, the Washington State Department of Revenue (DOR) is the administrator of the legacy program. Currently, the WSU Energy Program is working closely with DOR to ensure a smooth transition.

Pacific Power will no longer manage the program for the Washington State Department of Revenue. The new administrator will be the WSU Energy Program.
