Dear Judge Berg:

Pursuant to the Commission's June 27, 2002, Notice of Prehearing Conference for Part "E" of Docket UT-003013, the notice invites parties that wish to raise any other matter at the prehearing conference to advise the bench and the other parties via e-mail no later than 1:00pm on Wednesday, July 10, 2002. This letter is in response to that invitation.

At paragraphs 50 - 51 of the Part "B" Order (32nd Supplemental Order in UT-003013), the Commission discusses the interrelationship of OSS and nonrecurring rates (i.e. NRCs). Paragraph 51 explicitly states that, in addition to OSS Transition Cost Updates in Part "E", Qwest and Verizon, "must also file updated nonrecurring cost studies supported by time and motion studies that reflect decreased work times that have been achieved through their increasingly mechanized processes." (*emphasis added*)

Staff would like to discuss the impact of this decision as it relates to NRC cost studies filed in Part "D". Although briefs are due on July 19, 2002, on numerous NRCs filed in Part "D"; Staff believes it would make more sense to extract all NRCs filed in Part "D" and to relocate all NRCs into Part "E" as anticipated in the Commission's Part "B" order. This would have the effect of cutting the Part "D" briefs approximately in half, and would address the Commission's mandate (to file updated nonrecurring cost studies) in a more efficient and effective manner - all at once within the new, more accommodating Part "E" schedule.
