RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Avista Corporation, d/b/a Avista Utilities*, Docket UE-160082

TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 28, 2016, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Allowing Tariff Revisions to Become Effective Subject to Conditions (Order 01) in this docket. Order 01, among other things, approved an Electric Vehicle Supply Pilot Program (Pilot Program) and required Avista Corporation, d/b/a Avista Utilities, (Avista or Company) to file quarterly reports documenting program participation levels, expenditures, and revenues for each service offered under the Pilot Program, with a final report due August 1, 2018.

On February 8, 2018, the Commission entered Order 02, Granting Petition; Allowing Tariff Revisions to Become Effective (Order 02). Order 02 extended Avista's Pilot Program, and set a deadline for the final report to be filed by December 31, 2019.

Avista filed its final report on October 17, 2019.

On January 10, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that Staff had reviewed the report and believes that it complies with the requirements of Order 02.

The Commission accepts the final report as in compliance with Order 02.
