TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 18, 2021, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 03 Related to the Suspension of Disconnection of Energy Services for Nonpayment and Adopting Related Requirements (Order 03) in the above-referenced docket.

On May 28, 2021, the Public Counsel Unit of the Attorney General Office (Public Counsel) filed with the Commission a Petition for Reconsideration of Order 03 and a Petition for Stay (Petitions).
