
PacifiCorp respectfully requests a 15 day extension in order to comply with certain reporting requirements for environmental expenditures as provided for in the Order. In paragraph 13b, the Order states, "The due date of the reports shall coincide with the due dates for the Company's quarterly results of operations. The first report will be submitted no later than May 15, 2005."

The 15 day extension is requested in order to comport with WAC 480-100-275, Subpart D, Quarterly Reporting Requirement, which reads: "Within sixty days of the end of each quarter, each electric utility must file a report of actual results for Washington operations." Pursuant to this regulation, the quarterly report and the accompanying environmental remediation expenditures report would not be due until May 30, 2005.
