ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING AND 11 **HEARING** 12 CWA, Inc. ("CWA") protests the above-captioned application of Diamond-West 13 Transportation Co., Inc. ("Applicant") under WAC 480-30-032. CWA requests that the WUTC 14 commence an adjudicative proceeding and set this application for hearing for the reasons identified in this protest. 16 CWA is an auto transportation company operating under authority issued by the 17 WUTC in Permit C-1073. See Attachment. Under this authority, CWA provides scheduled 18 airport transportation service between Yakima, Ellensburg, and Cle Elum on one hand, and on 19 the other hand the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport and the Seattle Amtrak station. CWA 20 operates and maintains in Washington a fleet of one - 47 passenger motorcoach and three -21 20 passenger minibuses used for the transportation of passengers and express service. CWA's 22 address is 1416 Whitehorn St., Ferndale, Washington, 98248. 23 CWA believes that a grant of Applicant's application is not in the public interest 24 and is not required by the public convenience and necessity. Applicant requests authority to 25 provide door-to-door and scheduled service between Seattle and Ellensburg with service to 26

•	points, and points within one mile of I-90, via I-90, SR-10, SR-906, I-405, and SR-520, which
3	could be interpreted as including Sea-Tac Airport. CWA already provides satisfactory service
4	along the portions of this route within its certificated territory. There is no public need for the
5	Applicant's proposed, duplicative service, as CWA's existing equipment is not fully utilized and
6	is available to provide additional service should the need and opportunity arise. CWA also
7	believes that the Applicant is not fit, willing, and able to provide the proposed service in
8 9	accordance with the applicable laws, rules, and regulations.
10	If the WUTC sets this matter for hearing, CWA will appear, submit evidence, and
11	present witnesses at the hearing in support of this protest. CWA will represent itself in this
12	proceeding and will be represented by its attorneys, Brooks E. Harlow and David L. Rice.
