- 1 On July 30, 2004, the Commission entered Order No. 08 in Docket No. UT-043007 and Order No. 01 in Docket No. UT-043068, Order Approving Petition to Modify SGAT Exhibit B and Interconnection Agreements Containing Exhibit B, Order Approving, In Part, Petition to Modify SGAT Exhibit K and Interconnection Agreements Containing Exhibit K (SGAT Order).

- 2 On August 11, 2004, Qwest Corporation filed clean and redlined copies of the revised Fifth Amended Exhibit K to Qwest's Washington SGAT Eighth Revision.

- 3 The Commission finds that the revised Fifth Amended Exhibit K filed with the Commission on August 11, 2004, complies with paragraphs 24 through 26 of the Commission's Order No. 07 in Docket No. UT-043007 and Order No. 01 in Docket No. UT-043068 and that the revised Fifth Amended Exhibit K should be approved and become effective immediately.
