Nick Temme, Regional Manager, was contacted on 11/24/08 to set up a date for a compliance review. The date for the review was set for 12/17/08 at their location in Seattle.

Nick Temme was called on December 12, 2008 to ensure that the company would be prepared for the compliance review.

A compliance review was completed on this company on December 17, 2008 with the following results. This is a terminal of the Parent company of Gentle Giant located in Massachusetts. The operations are included under the parent companies DOT # 373544, There has been some confusion as to what DOT# they are operating under. This information was confirmed with their corporate office, See Attached email from Lisa Rivard.

The company at this time has only been operating in Intra-State operations. They plan on expanding to include Inter-State operations in the near future.

The companies Drug and Alcohol program as per CFR Title 49 Part 382 was checked and found to be in compliance. The company does not have any CDL drivers at this time but have their drug testing program in place.

The company has two drivers that were checked for compliance of the requirements on CFR Title 49 Part 383. The drivers Licences were checked and found to be in compliance. Two attempts to get unto the CDLIS to check the drivers licences was unsuccessful.

The companies Insurance was checked to ensure compliance with the requirements of CFR Title 49 Part 387 and was found to be in compliance.

The company was checked for compliance of the FMCSR general and it was found that the company was in compliance and had the current CFR Title 49. The company also provides copies of CFR Title 49 to their drivers.

The company offered their driver qualification files as required in CFR Title 49, part 391. The company was found to be in compliance.

The company was checked for compliance of CFR Title 49 Part 393. The company operates two vehicles, One was available and offered for inspection. The other vehicle is a pack van and does not meet the definition of a commercial vehicle. A CVSA level 5 inspection was performed and the vehicle passed the inspection and was issued a CVSA inspection decal # 9480987.

The company was checked for compliance of CFR Title 49 Part 395. The drivers hours were checked and found to be in compliance. the company is using time cards at this point but will be changing to using drivers daily logs.

The company was checked for compliance of CFR Title 49 Part 396. The company was found to be in compliance.

The requirements of CFR Title 49 that the company would be under once they start their Inter-State operations and begin to go over the 100 mile radius were gone over with Nick Temme, Regional Manager. The company is putting into place the changes that they will need to have to ensure full compliance at that time.

I feel that the company will make the appropriate changes as needed as their company continues to grow. I would recommend to close and file this assignment.
