Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are aware, on June 25, 2008, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("commission") issued a Penalty Assessment against Bumblebee Moving North, Inc. in the amount of \$300 for violation of commission rules requiring household goods carriers to file annual reports by May 1 each year. Bumblebee Moving North, Inc. failed to file its 2005, 2006 and 2007 annual reports, and has incurred a penalty of \$100 per violation.

The commission has not received the \$300 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$300 balance.
