

SUBJECT: Docket TV-082048; Application for Permanent Authority

On November 12, 2008, Coleman American Moving Services, Inc., filed Docket TV-082048 requesting permanent household goods authority.

The Commission granted the company temporary authority subject to conditions pending a decision on its application for permanent authority. The company has operated under Household Goods Carrier Permit No. THG-63450, since December 8, 2008.


Under WAC 480-15-330, the commission will grant or deny an application for permanent authority after conducting a complete review of the application filings, supporting statements, reports, or other information necessary to determine fitness, public interest, and current or future public convenience and necessity.


Compliance staff worked with the company providing technical assistance during its temporary operations. Investigator Tom McVaugh completed a Safety Compliance Review, a Household Goods Technical Assistance and Records Review Checklist. Investigator McVaugh found the company in general compliance and on April 21, 2009, he recommended the applicant be considered for permanent authority.

The current provisional permit THG-63450 is in order as follows:

- Records Center has a current annual report on file.
- Financial Services reports the company has paid appropriate regulatory fees.
- The commission does not have any outstanding penalty or other fine against HG-63450.
- Compliance Investigations does not have a pending consumer complaint.
- Transportation Safety does not have a pending compliance action.
- *Co attendal mandatory AHA now entered training on Oct, 2008.*

I recommend the commission grant TV-082048 without hearing and reissue Permit No. HG-63450 to Coleman American Moving Services, Inc., as unrestricted permanent authority to operate as a household goods carrier in the state of Washington.
