Dear Secretary:

Enclosed herewith are proposed tariff 5, pages 1, 18, 22-24, 28-9 and 31-2 for Basin Disposal of Yakima, LLC, issued November 9, 2009 to become effective January 1, 2010. The revisions are due to an increase in Yakima County disposal fees from \$27.03 to \$30.89 per ton, a 14.3% increase as of January 1, 2010. The revenue increase will be \$9,688 for drop box service, \$10,826 (5.14%) for residential customers, \$18,611 (5.14%) for commercial packer customers, overall (1.1% of total revenue) and 34 cents per month (1 can weekly service). Customers received notices of the changes with the first billing reflecting the increases.
