- 1. "Under the Administrative Procedure Act (RCW 34.05) (Laws of 2009, ch. 358), the commission will waive any fines, civil penalties, or administrative sanctions for first-time paperwork violations by a small business, with certain exceptions. One of those exceptions provides that any violation of a substantially similar paperwork requirement (as described in Part B on this form) may result in the imposition of a fine, civil penalty or other administrative sanction. The company will not be entitled to a second waiver of penalties for "first-time" paperwork violations. - 2. Ensure that each driver qualification file is complete. At a minimum, it should contain a DOT type employment application, background investigation including an initial copy of the driving record, medical certification, and road test or CDL equivalent. Drivers who have been employed at least twelve months should have a current violation list, abstract of driving record and a documented annual review of driving record in file. See 49 CFR Part 391 for more information.
- 3. Ensure that drivers comply with the federal and state hours of service standard found in 49 CFR Part 395. Property carrying drivers are restricted to 11 hours driving and 14 hours on duty following 10 consecutive hours off duty. Instruct drivers in how to comply with these rules as well as the 34 hour reset and 60/70 hour on duty restriction. Monitor hours of service records to prevent violations. Appropriate hours of service standards are important to addressing a major facotr identified in many vehicle crashes--fatigue.
- 4. Require all drivers to prepare a written inspection report for each day a vehicle is operated. Ensure that each report is signed by the driver, certified, and reviewed if defects are reported.
- 5. Ensure that maintenance files properly identify each vehicle with year, make, serial number and tire size. This requirement positively ties the vehicle to that file. The written maintenance record should include date and type of inspection or repair that was performed. Preventive maintenance showed be performed on a regular schedule based on time, mileage, hours operated or other means that may be specified by the manufacturer.

Thunder Movers LLC is an Oregon based company that operates in several jurisdictions including Washington intrastate, Oregon intrastate, commercial zone and federal interstate. For the purposes of safety enforcement, all vehicles laden or unladen begin their trip from the principal place of business at Portland, Oregon. This company has operated several years with the same management team. Dottie RedThunder and V Mychal Red Thunder are members and managers. Stacy Labenske, office manager, gave access to the safety records and was interviewed during this review.

The firm does not act as an agent for any other carrier. There was no evidence that any other carrier operates from these offices. Gross reviews for the calendar year 2010 were not readily available as specific accounting records were not available. The company made few Washington intrastate hauls and paid minimal regulatory fees. This is a small business. The firm has never met the criteria as a federal Class I or Class II motor carrier for financial reporting purposes.

The company operates commercial motor vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,000 pounds or less.

Canal Insurance Company is the insurer affording coverage for public liability and property damage insurance under Policy PIA505074002 with combined single limits of \$1,000,000. Cargo insurance with limits of \$50,000 is underwritten by Allianz Global Corporate & Specialty under policy MX193022606.

Carrier management has general knowledge of the federal motor carrier safety regulations as they apply to current operations. Vehicles are marked and identified. There have been no recordable crashes in the past year.

The company is registered under the Unified Carrier Registration program. A variation of the former HGCB Tariff 400N is used for creating rates on interstate hauls. Tariff 15-C published by the Washington Utilities & Transportation Commission is used for Washington intrastate residential household goods hauls.

Drivers are properly licensed and medically qualified. The drivers were screened through Query Central and there was no recent history of license suspension or revocation. The firm is in the process of completing current violation lists and notations for annual review of driving record.

Carrier officials are aware of the rules of the road. They know about the potential hazards of distracted driving, driver fatigue and serious traffic violations.

One commercial motor vehicle was offered for service and available for inspection. No out of service condition was found.

This property carrying motor carrier is in general compliance with the 11, 14 and 70 hour hours of service rules. They take advantage of the 34 hour reset. Most operations are local in nature and conducted within a 150 air mile radius of the normal work reporting location. Time cards and/or daily records of duty status document hours worked. Supporting documents include dispatch sheets, bills of lading and other information.

The carrier has created a written maintenance record for vehicle. The preventative maintenance consists of regular service based on time or mileage operated. The company maintains records of vendor receipts for work performed by others. Annual (periodic) inspection requirements were discussed. A few driver vehicle inspection reports were missing or mis-filed. Drivers were to be reminded that a DVIR must be filed for each day the vehicle operates and it should meet the requirements of 49 CFR 396.11.

Management was cooperative during this compliance review. The compliance review was conducted because the firm must qualify for permanent Washington intrastate household goods authority based on a satisfactory safety rating using FMCSA rating criteria. It is anticipated that the carrier would be recommended for the permanent authority based on the findings in this review.

Company officials were offered additional educational and technical assistance on federal or state commercial vehicle safety issues as they might come up in the future. The company was advised to review their FMCSA CSA standing on a regular basis.
