From August 22 to 26, 2011, representatives of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC), pursuant to Chapter 601 of 49 United States Code, inspected your crude oil pipeline facilities in the State of Washington. As a result of the inspection, Kinder Morgan Canada, Inc. was issued a Notice of Amendment on February 28, 2012, which proposed amendment of your procedures.
