Puget Sound and Pacific Railroad has filed petitions with the Utilities and Transportation Commission to close two rail-road crossings. The crossings are located at:

North 17th Street UTC Reference No. TR-110162
Hewitt Street UTC Reference No. TR-110157

Puget Sound and Pacific Railroad also filed three petitions to close the North 2nd Street (UTC Reference No. TR-110159), North 5th Street (UTC Reference No. TR-110160) and North 10th Street (UTC Reference No. TR-110161) crossings in Elma.
