- On May 2, 2011, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued Penalty Assessment TE-110698 against Agate Pass Transportation, LLC d/b/a Agate Pass Transportation (Agate Pass) in the amount of \$600, alleging six violations of WAC 480-30-221, Vehicle and driver safety requirements, which requires passenger charter carriers to comply with Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, including Part 382, which governs controlled substance and alcohol use and testing.
- 2 On May 16, 2011, Agate Pass filed with the Commission a request for hearing and a decision by an administrative law judge.
- On May 26, 2011, Commission Staff filed a Response stating that it does not oppose Agate Pass's Request for Hearing and recommends that Agate Pass's mitigation request, seeking an unspecified reduction in the penalty amount, be denied.
- Pursuant to RCW 34.05.482 and WAC 480-07-610, the Commission determines that a brief adjudicative proceeding is appropriate for determining whether the penalty should be mitigated and what actions are necessary for Agate Pass to maintain future compliance, pursuant to statutory provisions of RCW 81.04.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That it will hold a brief adjudicative proceeding in this matter at 1:30 p.m., on Wednesday, July 6, 2011, in Room 108, First Floor, Richard Hemstad Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., Olympia, Washington.

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The record in this case will consist of any documents regarding the matter that are considered by or prepared for the presiding officer for the brief adjudicative proceeding and a transcript of any oral statements given at the hearing, which statements will be given under oath.

- Written notice of any other stage in the proceeding or other formal proceedings that the Commission may deem appropriate will be given during the course of this case. The Commission will provide at its offices in Olympia, Washington, copies of documents in the current record for use by the parties or others who may want to review them.
- Parties wishing to submit any other documents for consideration at the brief adjudicative proceeding must file with the Commission a list enumerating and describing any such documents no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, **June 24, 2011**, and bring an original and three (3) copies to the hearing. Filing shall be in accordance with WAC 480-07-140 and 145.
- THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE that any party who fails to attend or participate in the brief adjudicative proceeding set by this Notice, or any other stage of this proceeding, may be held in default under RCW 34.05.440 and WAC 480-07-450.
