RE: Notice of Intent to Send to Collections, Penalty Assessment No. UT-121025

Dear Mr. Zwebner:

As you are aware, on August 1, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued a Penalty Assessment against Yak Communications (America), Inc. (Yak Communications), in the amount of \$900 for violation of WAC 480-120-382, which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file an annual report with the Commission by May 1 each year. Yak Communications filed its 2011 annual report on May 25, 2012, which is 18 business days past the deadline, and also failed to meet the deadline for its 2008 annual report, incurring an additional penalty. The Commission entered Order 01 on September 26, 2012, mitigating and reducing the penalty to \$150, with conditions. The Commission sent Yak Communications a Corrected Second Notice on September 28, 2012, and a Final Notice on October 31, 2012.

The Commission has not received the \$150 payment due and owing.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$150 balance.
