Re: D-141448 Penalty Assessment

Dear Mr. King:

On Aug. 28, 2014, BCA Directional Drilling LLC (BCA) was issued a \$1,000 penalty for a violation of RCW 19.122. BCA had the option to have the penalty waived on the conditions that (1) BCA attend "Dig Safe" training provided through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA); and (2) that BCA commit no further violations of RCW 19.122.030 within the next 12 months. On Sept. 5, 2014, the commission received notification from BCA that the company admitted the violation occurred and accepted the commission's offer to waive the penalty on the stated conditions.

On April 30, 2015, NUCA conducted a "Dig Safe" training. NUCA provided the commission documentation that employees of BCA attended the "Dig Safe" training. The first condition of the penalty waiver has been met.
