Completion of Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) Project

N SE Road (USDOT #396956E)

On September 22, 2015, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) awarded a GCPF grant totaling \$20,000 to Columbia Basin Railroad (CBRR) for a project to upgrade active warning devices at the N SE Road crossing in Grant county (USDOT #396956E). The estimated total project cost was \$20,000, with CBRR paying any costs over that amount. The actual cost of the project was \$22,148.36.

On February 5, 2016, CBRR submitted a request for reimbursement. On February 16, 2016, Rail Safety staff met with CBRR personnel and confirmed that the project was completed according to the specifications outlined in the order approving the grant.
