Dear Kathy Hunter:

This letter is to officially inform your office that Yakima County will no longer pursue funding for a Constant Warning Time System for railroad crossing # 099216G located at Lateral A road and Branch Road.

Yakima County had filed a petition seeking funds for an approval of modification of highway-rail grade crossing warning signals and disbursement of funds from the Grade Crossing Protective Fund under docket #TR-160188. Staff prepared plans and specifications and advertised a bid in April 2016. Bids were received, and the lowest bid was 50% over the engineer's estimate.

As conditions exist, it is deemed unpredictable that even after revising plans and specifications and scaling down the current scope of the project that, a reasonable bid to accomplish the project would be achieved. Further, Yakima County does not have to cover any over runs.
