Commission Staff's Response to Proposed Payment Schedule
Consolidated Docket: TV-180132 & TV-180133

Dear Mr. King:

On April 16, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 01 in consolidated dockets TV-180132 & TV-180133 which granted Keiko Martinez d/b/a U-Relax Moving & Delivery Service's (Keiko Martinez) request for mitigation of a \$8,300 penalty to \$2,075.

On April 23, 2018, Ms. Keiko Martinez contacted Commission Staff with a proposed penalty payment schedule consisting of 10 monthly payments of \$200, and a final payment of \$75.

Staff supports the payment plan proposed by Keiko Martinez, under the following conditions:

1. The company will make 10 monthly installments of \$200, and a final installment of \$75, for a total of \$2,075.
2. Each payment will be due and payable on the first business day of each month, beginning June 1, 2018.
3. If the company fails to pay any installment by the due date, or fails to pay at least the minimum amount due, the entire remaining balance of payments will become immediately due and payable.
