RE: In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against Pro Grade Enterprises, Inc. in the Amount of \$3,500 for Two Violations of RCW 19.122, Docket DG-180203

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 16, 2018, the Commission issued a penalty assessment against Pro Grade Enterprises, Inc. (Pro Grade or Company) for two violations of RCW 19.122. In the penalty assessment, the Commission offered to waive \$2,500 of the penalty on the conditions that Pro Grade management and employees attend Dig Safe training provided by the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the date of the penalty assessment, and that Pro Grade committed no further violations of RCW 19.122 during those 12 months.

On April 3, 2018, Pro Grade filed a response to the penalty assessment, accepting the conditions offered.

On April 5, 2019, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Pro Grade has not attended NUCA Dig Safe training, and recommending the Commission impose the \$2,500 suspended portion of the penalty.

Due to Pro Grade's failure to comply with the agreed conditions by attending NUCA Dig Safe training, the \$2,500 suspended portion of the penalty is now due and payable.
