Failure to Comply with the Stipulated Conditions Set Forth in Order 01

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On July 25, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) penalized Luxury1 Limo, LLC (Luxury1 Limo or Company) \$1,400 for violations of Washington Administrative Code 480-30-221 Vehicle and Driver Safety Requirements. On August 29, 2018, the company requested mitigation of the penalty.

On September 21, 2018, the Commission issued Order 01, denying mitigation, but suspending \$700 of the penalty for two years, then dismissing it, on three conditions. The Company must have no repeat acute or critical safety violations, pay the remaining \$700 penalty within 10 days of the order, and submit a "15-day letter" to Staff within 10 days of the order containing its plan for correcting and avoiding future violations.

As of November 1, 2018, the Company has failed to pay the remaining penalty or submit its 15-day letter. Staff recommends that the full penalty amount of \$1,400 become immediately due and payable.
