Completion of Grade Crossing Protective Fund (GCPF) Project

Walnut Street - USDOT 090168N

On Aug. 16, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (UTC) awarded a GCPF grant totaling \$19,084 to the City of Bingen (City) for a project related to modifying active warning devices at the Walnut Street crossing (USDOT 090168N). This crossing was identified in the 2014 Marine and Rail Oil Transportation Study as an under-protected crossing on an oil route. The actual cost of this portion of the project was \$231,829.87. WSDOT funds are covering the remaining project costs.

This crossing was identified in the 2014 Marine and Rail Oil Transportation Study as an underprotected crossing on an oil route.

On Jul. 15, 2019, the City submitted a request for reimbursement. Rail Safety staff inspected the crossing and confirmed that this portion of the project was completed according to the specifications outlined in the order approving the grant.
