RE: *In the Matter of the Penalty Assessment Against JSB Contractors LLC in the Amount of \$2,000, Docket D-190239*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 16, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) assessed a \$2,000 penalty (Penalty Assessment) against JSB Contractors LLC (JSB or Company) for two violations of Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 19.122. In the Penalty Assessment, the Commission offered the Company the option to suspend, and ultimately waive, \$1,500 of the penalty subject to the conditions that (1) the Company pay the \$500 remaining portion of the penalty; (2) Company foremen attend Dig Safe training provided through the National Utility Contractors Association (NUCA) within 12 months of the date of the Penalty Assessment; and (3) the Company commit no further violations of RCW 19.122 within 12 months from the date of the Penalty Assessment.

On May 3, 2019, the Company paid the \$500 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and notified the Commission that it accepted the remaining conditions.

On April 16, 2020, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter informing the Commission that the Company had met all of the conditions. In its letter, Staff recommended the Commission waive the \$1,500 suspended portion of the penalty and close the docket.

The Commission agrees that JSB has complied with the conditions of the penalty suspension. The \$1,500 suspended portion of the penalty is thus waived, and this docket is closed.
