Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Tiraogo Simpore Commission Staff's Response to Request for Payment Arrangements Docket TV-190298 and TV-190299 (Consolidated)

Dear Mr. Johnson:

On June 20, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment under Docket TV-190298 and TV-190299 (*Consolidated*) against Tiraogo Simpore d/b/a TS Moving Services (TS Moving or Company) in the amount of \$1,300 for 79 violations of Washington Administrative Code 480-15-550, Cargo Insurance; WAC 480-15-555, Criminal Background Checks for Prospective Employees; and WAC 480-15-570, Driver Safety Requirements, which adopts Title 49 CFR Part 391 – Qualifications of Drivers; and Title 49 CFR Part 395 – Hours of Service of Drivers.

On June 27, 2019, TS Moving contacted Commission Staff (Staff) and proposed payment arrangements for the \$1,300 portion of the penalty that is not suspended. Staff supports the Company's proposed monthly payments as follows:
