Tesoro and Tesoro Logistics changed their names to Andeavor and Andeavor Logistics on June 1, 2017 after Tesoro purchased Western Refining.

Marathon Petroleum purchased Andeavor (excluding Andeavor Logistics) on October 1, 2018.

The sale of Andeavor Logistics to Marathon Logistics closed on July 30, 2019.

The Vancouver terminal has been – and continues to be - operated by the logistics companies of their respective parent companies.

The terminal in Vancouver is a facility leased from the Port of Vancouver.
