1 On March 4, 2020, The Rock Transportation Services Corporation, d/b/a Whidbey SeaTac Shuttle & Charter, filed an application with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) in accordance with RCW 81.68 requesting extension of service under passenger transportation company certificate C001077 to provide the following service:

AIRPORTER PASSENGER SERVICE: transporting passengers between SeaTac International Airport and Paine Field Airport, combining with routes from Whidbey Island to SeaTac International Airport.

- 2 The application appeared on the March 9, 2020 application docket. The application was unopposed.
- In support of the request to extend its authority, The Rock Transportation Services Corporation provided several letters from members of the public who live in the communities involved. Their letters indicate a need for service that is currently not served on the route.
- 4 The Commission, having considered the application and being fully advised, finds that The Rock Transportation Services Corporation is fit, willing, and able to provide the proposed service and that the proposed service is necessary and will be a convenience to the public.
- 5 After reviewing the evidence submitted and due to the fact that no service of this nature is presently available over this route, the Commission will issue the requested authority.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

(1) The application filed by The Rock Transportation Services Corporation, d/b/a Whidbey SeaTac Shuttle & Charter, in Docket TC-200149, is granted, conditioned upon compliance with the laws and rules governing passenger transportation companies, and that passenger transportation company certificate C001077 is amended to read as follows:

AUTO TRANSPORTATION SERVICE by reservation only:

BETWEEN: Whidbey Island and Seattle.

AIRPORTER PASSENGER SERVICE BETWEEN: Whidbey Island and Paine Field Airport, combining with routes from Whidbey Island to SeaTac International Airport, including transporting passengers between Paine Field and SeaTac International Airport.

CLOSED DOOR SERVICE BETWEEN: Seattle and the SeaTac International Airport. No passengers may be transported between points in Seattle and SeaTac International Airport.

PASSENGER SERVICE by reservation only:

AIRPORTER PASSENGER SERVICE BETWEEN: Whidbey Island and SeaTac International Airport via Deception Pass or the Clinton Ferry; Door to door service in conjunction with the above route; Oak Harbor and Lupien Field.

AUTO TRANSPORTATION SERVICE by reservation only:

BETWEEN: Oak Harbor and Coupeville; Coupeville and the Keystone Ferry; Langley and Clinton.

BETWEEN: Oak Harbor and hotels and motels within a 1-mile radius and hotels and motels within a 1-mile radius of the SeaTac International Airport.

CLOSED DOOR SERVICE: BETWEEN Deception Pass and SeaTac International Airport and BETWEEN the Clinton Ferry and SeaTac International Airport.

SCHEDULED PASSENGER SERVICE by reservation only:

AIRPORTER PASSENGER SERVICE BETWEEN: Whidbey Island and Paine Field Airport.

CLOSED DOOR SERVICE BETWEEN: Deception Pass and Paine Field and BETWEEN the Clinton Ferry and Paine Field.

Charter and Excursion Carrier Services in the state of Washington.

Including services limited to specific auto transportation services granted with forbearance from rate and service regulation under RCW 81-68-015 in Docket TC-140159, Order 01, as follows:

BETWEEN: Whidbey Island and King County Convention Center, CenturyLink Stadium or Safeco Field for sporting shows and events, boat shows and events, home shows and events, RV shows and events, and golf shows and events; AND

BETWEEN: Whidbey Island and Sporting events, concerts, casinos, wineries, and performing arts theaters in Washington.

NOTE: Nothing in this certificate authorizes transportation between SeaTac International Airport and hotels and motels within a 1-mile radius of SeaTac.

(2) The tariff and time schedule filed in connection with this application will become effective at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the service date of this Order.

The Commission has delegated authority to the Secretary to enter this Order under RCW 80.01.030 and WAC 480-07-905(6)(a).

Following hearing, the administrative law judge will enter an initial order. If you wish to seek review of the initial order, you may file a petition for administrative review under RCW

34.05.464, or if the matter is heard in a brief adjudicative proceeding, under RCW 34.05.491.
