D-210067– Kyle Mathison Orchards - Investigation # 8334

Dear Ms. Maxwell

Commission staff (staff) has reviewed the compliance order for Kyle Mathison Orchards (KMO or Company) dated April 6, 2021. Compliance with the order required the following:

- \$3,000 penalty for three violations of RCW 19.122, with the opportunity to suspend, and ultimately waive the \$3,000 penalty amount on the conditions: (1) the Company supervisors and applicable field staff attend NUCA Dig Safe online training and; (2) the Company incurs no other dig law violations within 12 months.

On April 19, 2021, KMO notified the Commission of its acceptance of the conditions. On March 29, 2022, the Company verified completion of the training, and the Company has not incurred any additional violations of the dig law since the penalty assessment.

Staff believes KMO has fully complied with the Commission's order, and further compliance under this order is no longer necessary. Staff recommends the Commission waive the suspended \$3,000 penalty amount and close the docket.
