Commission Staff's Response to Request for Payment Arrangements

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On April 26, 2022, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a penalty assessment against Queen City Business Movers, LLC, d/b/a Queen City Movers, (Queen City or Company) in the amount of \$5,700 for violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15-570, Driver Safety Requirements.

On April 28, 2022, Queen City filed with the Commission its application for mitigation of penalties. On May 5, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed a response recommending the Commission deny the Company's request for mitigation of penalties.

On May 16, 2022, the Company contacted the Commission and requested to pay the penalty in installments.

On June 8, 2022, the Commission entered Order 01, which denied the Company's request to mitigate the \$5,700 penalty and instructed the Company to work with Staff to file a mutually agreeable payment plan no later than June 20, 2022.

On June 8, 2022, Staff and Queen City came to a mutual agreement on a proposed payment plan, as follows:
