Dear Mr. Killip:

Thank you for the opportunity to file comments in this very important docket. The Safety Committee understands and supports the law imposing a broad responsibility upon the facility operator to mark the location of any locatable facilities, even if they are unmapped.

Over the years, there have been multiple cases presented to the Safety Committee where facilities were unmapped, but not once has the facility operator been granted an exception to their ownership of the plant in the ground, nor their liability. In other words, no (or inaccurate) mapping does not make a facility unlocatable.

In this instance where an entire street has been located and there is one home in the middle of the block with no gas, a reasonable person would have questioned and investigated further. The term "unlocatable" in the dig law is meant to address facilities that cannot be located due to the type of material of the facility that was installed or the manner that it was installed (no tracer wire or conductive material was used) rather than the fact its existence is unknown.

Finally, by Avista's own account of the situation, they had two other gas stubs that were located and marked on the 1500-foot residential locate. The fact that the gas stub in question wasn't marked doesn't make it unlocatable, it makes it an error.
