The above-entitled matter, which is in the nature of a complaint against Marine View Heights Incorporation, was filed on March 9, 1994. Respondent filed its answer on April 8, 1994. The pleadings indicate a dispute exists between the complainants and respondent relating to, inter alia, the purity, quality, volume, and pressure of water; re-connection charges; and failure by respondent to 1) maintain a regular business location and telephone number at which it can be contacted by customers; 2) indicate the date on which bills would become delinquent and a means by which a customer could contact the nearest business office of respondent; 3) maintain its plant and system so as to be able to furnish adequate service; 4) provide a guide detailing the rights and responsibilities of its customers; 5) inform dissatisfied customers of the availability of the Commission for review of any disputes; 6) refrain from damaging a customer's property; 7) bill and collect in an even-handed manner from all customers; and, 8) properly state information on notices to water customers. Complainants also seek a refund under RCW 80.04.110 for alleged substandard water delivered to water customers and that the Commission determine that the water rates of respondent are unjust and unreasonable.

A more detailed account of the issues is reflected in the foregoing pleadings which are available for inspection at the Commission's office, Chandler Plaza Building, 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive SW, Olympia, Washington. The response having been filed, it is appropriate that the matters raised in the pleadings be brought on for hearing before the Commission.

The hearing hereinafter set is being held pursuant to Part IV of chapter 34.05 RCW pertaining to adjudicative proceedings, including but not limited to RCW 34.05.413, RCW 34.05.440, RCW 34.05.449, and RCW 34.05.452. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Title 80 RCW under which it regulates the rates, services, and practices of water companies providing service within the state of Washington. Statutes and rules cited by the complainants include Title 80 RCW, RCW 80.04.110, 80.04.120, 80.04.170, 80.04.220, 80.04.380, 80.04.385, 80.04.440, 80.28.010, 80.28.020, 80.28.030, 80.28.040. 80.28.050,

80.28.060, 80.28.080, 80.28.090, and 80.28.100; and WAC 480-110-041, 480-110-071, 480-110-076, 480-110-096, and 480-110-101. In addition to the foregoing, statutes involved are those within chapter 80.04, including but not limited to RCW 80.04.230, 80.04.240, 80.04.405, and RCW 80.04.450, as well as those within chapter 80.28 RCW relating to the charges and practices of water companies. Rules involved include WAC 480-110-111 and those within chapter 480-110 WAC relating to water service, and chapter 480-09 WAC.

In addition, complainants have raised the following statutes and rules: RCW 70.119 and WAC 246-290-020(3), 246-290-100, 246-290-120, 246-290-250(3), 246-290-300(2), 246-290-310(3), 246-290-320(1), 246-290-330, 246-290-330(h), 246-290-400, 246-290-420, 246-290-440, and 246-290-480.

The issues involved are generally stated above and more specifically contained in the complaint herein. The burden of proving that effective water rates are unreasonable rests on the complainants.
