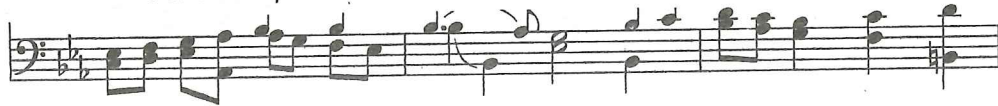
Break forth O beauteous heavenly light Our human heat awakening

Rise up great leadership kind and wise, with guidance from creation



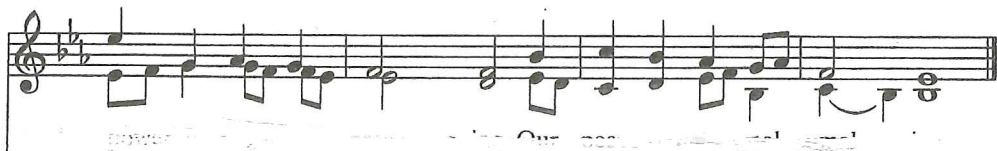
Dear government please disarm; and join the peaceful praying
