

Ability to Remain Functional in Emergencies Certification §54.313(a)(6)

ETCs must demonstrate that it has a reasonable amount of back-up power to ensure functionality without an external power source, is able to re-route traffic around damaged facilities, and is capable of managing traffic spikes resulting from emergency situations.

Re: Inland Cellular LLC (f/k/a Washington RSA No. 8 Limited Partnership)
(SAC 529003) (“Company”)

The Company is able to remain functional in emergencies as set forth in Commission Order No. 29841 and in 47 C.F.R. §54.201(a)(2), as such standards relate to functionality of wireless carriers in emergency situations. The Company maintains back-up power to ensure functionality without an external power source in the forms of auxiliary generators and batteries in its central office and auxiliary generators and/or batteries at its cellular tower locations. The Company also constantly monitors traffic on its tower locations and its switching capability is more than adequate to manage the traffic of its subscribers.

The Company is able to re-route traffic around damaged facilities. All Inland Cellular subscribers are defaulted to roam on competitors should an Inland Cellular signal not be obtained.
