**NOTICE REQUIRING FILING OF SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS  
(By August 5, 2022)**

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Puget Sound Energy*,  
Dockets UE-220066, UG-220067, and UG-210918 (*Consolidated*)

TO ALL PARTIES:

On January 31, 2022, Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-60, Tariff G, Electric Service, and its currently effective Tariff WN U-2, Natural Gas. The Company characterizes this filing as a general rate case (GRC).

On March 3, 2022, the Commission entered Order 03, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing, which established a procedural schedule that includes, among other things, an evidentiary hearing set for October 3, 2022 and October 4, 2022.

On July 11, 2022, counsel for PSE contacted the presiding officer on behalf of the parties to inform the Commission that a partial multiparty settlement in principle on the Green Direct issue has been reached by the following parties: Commission staff, PSE, King County and Walmart Inc. (Settling Parties). PSE notes that the Public Counsel Unit of the Attorney General's Office participated in developing the settlement and will let parties and the Commission know if it will join the settlement prior to the settlement and supporting testimony being filed with the Commission. PSE submits that no other party in the case who is authorized to intervene on the Green Direct issue opposes the settlement.

The Commission finds good cause to adopt PSE's proposal and to require the filing of the aforementioned partial multiparty settlement. The Settling Parties must therefore file a settlement agreement and supporting documentation by August 5, 2022. At that time, the Commission may

determine whether any additional process is necessary in light of the parties' respective positions. The procedural schedule in these consolidated dockets is otherwise maintained without change.

**THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the Settling Parties must file a settlement agreement and supporting documentation no later than August 5, 2022.**
