GRANTING AWEC'S MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, IN PART; DENYING MOTION IN PART

BACKGROUND

- On January 31, 2022, Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) revisions to its currently effective Tariff WN U-60, Tariff G, Electric Service, and its currently effective Tariff WN U-2, Natural Gas. The Commission initiated an adjudication in consolidated Dockets UE-220066 and UG-220067.
- 2 On February 28, 2022, the Commission convened a virtual prehearing conference before administrative law judge Michael S. Howard.

- On March 3, 2022, the Commission entered Order 03, Prehearing Conference Order and Notice of Hearing, noticing a hearing for October 3-4, 2022 (Order 03). Among other points, the Commission adopted a procedural schedule for this proceeding and noticed an evidentiary hearing for October 3, 2022, and October 4, 2022.
- On May 12, 2022, the Commission entered Order 14/01, Granting Motion to Consolidate. The Commission granted the motion by Commission staff (Staff) to consolidate Dockets UE-220066 and UG-220067 with Docket UG-210918, wherein PSE petitioned for an order authorizing deferred accounting treatment for the Company's share of costs associated with the Tacoma Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Facility.
- On July 12, 2022, AWEC filed a Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule (Motion). AWEC requests that the Commission modify the procedural schedule in this proceeding to allow the parties more time for settlement discussions prior to the filing of response testimony, which is currently due on July 19, 2022. AWEC proposes the following deadlines:
 - Staff, Public Counsel, and Intervenor Response Testimony and Exhibits due by July 28, 2022;
 - PSE Circulates Joint Issues Matrix due by August 2, 2022; and
 - PSE Rebuttal Testimony and Exhibits, and Staff, Public Counsel, and Intervenor Cross-Answering Testimony and Exhibits due by September 7, 2022.
- 6 AWEC submits that its Motion is unopposed by the other parties to this proceeding.

DISCUSSION

- Based on AWEC's unopposed Motion, the Commission finds good cause to amend the procedural schedule and grant's AWEC's Motion, in part. The Commission adopts AWEC's proposed modifications to the procedural schedule as set forth in Appendix A to this Notice, with the exception of the deadline for rebuttal and cross-answering testimony.
- The Commission instead sets the deadline for rebuttal and cross-answering testimony for Tuesday, August 30, 2022. It is reasonable and appropriate to adjust the deadlines for both response testimony and rebuttal and cross-answering testimony by approximately the same number of days. To further delay the filing of rebuttal and cross-answering testimony would hinder the Commission's ability to review the case before the evidentiary hearing.

ORDER

9 THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 10 (1) The Alliance of Western Energy Consumer's Motion is granted in part and denied in part.
- The Alliance of Western Energy Consumer's proposed, modified procedural schedule is adopted as Appendix A to this Notice with the exception of the deadline for rebuttal and cross-answering testimony, which is due on Tuesday, August 30, 2022, by 5 p.m.
