Qwest refers AT&T to the batch hot cut proposal filed by Qwest on November 12, 2003, and Qwest notes that the general subject matter has been discussed during the multi-state batch hot cut forum.

The system impact of the change is small and involves adding CLEC termination information into TIRKS. Circuits inventoried as UNE-P loops do not have to be migrated to a different inventory system. Unbundled loops and UNE-P loops are maintained in the same inventory systems.
