ICNU's member companies have a substantial interest in PSE's proposed adjustment to its power cost rate, which PSE filed as revisions to Tariff WN U-60 on May 23, 2014. The Company's proposed rate change would substantially and directly affect ICNU members who purchase power from PSE. ICNU requests leave to intervene in this proceeding to represent its members who would be affected by the proposed rate decrease.

As described above, ICNU has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding that will not be adequately represented by any other party, and may be affected by any Commission determination made in connection with this proceeding.
