RE: Avista Corporation – Dockets UE-220053/UG-220054/UE-210854 – Annual Reporting Obligations

Mr. Killip,

As part of the General Rate Case (2022 GRC) Settlement Stipulation approved by the Commission in the above referenced dockets, Avista agreed to the following related to its Annual Reporting Obligations:¹

Avista agrees to provide recommendations in its initial filing of its next GRC regarding how it will streamline its existing required annual reporting obligations (provided in Docket U-210151). Avista also agrees to provide a detailed matrix of all reporting obligations annually along with a matrix of any recommendations for streamlining, as provided in Docket U-210151.

On March 28, 2023, Avista filed a detailed matrix of its reporting obligations pursuant to this requirement. In its current pending General Rate Case (2024 GRC) filed on January 18, 2024, as required by the condition above, Avista provided recommendations regarding how its existing annual reporting obligations can be streamlined along with a detailed matrix of all of its reporting obligations.² Because the information included in its 2024 GRC is the same as what is required for the annual filing in its 2022 GRC, and to avoid duplicative filings, please see Dockets UE-240006 and UG-240007, SJB-4, for the matrix of the Company's reporting obligations.
