TO ALL PARTIES:

Advanced TelCom, Inc., Eschelon Telecom of Washington, Inc., Integra Telecom of Washington, Inc., Global Crossing Local Services, Inc., McLeodUSA Telecommunications, Inc., Pac-West Telecomm, Inc., Time Warner Telecom of Washington, LLC, and XO Washington, Inc. (collectively "Joint CLECs") filed a motion with the Commission today requesting that the Commission establish a procedure, or amend Order No. 02 in this proceeding, to permit disclosure of highly confidential information provided to the commission by competitive local exchange companies (CLECs) without disclosing the identity of the CLECs providing the information. Responses to Bench Requests issued in this proceeding are due to be filed with the Commission by Monday, November 17, 2003.
