Second Quarter ACP Exhibit 3 & 4 Updates

Dear Mr. King,

Attached are Puget Sound Energy's ("PSE's" or "the Company's") second quarter updates to its 2017 Exhibit 4: Measures, Incentives and Eligibility, originally filed as a part of PSE's 2017 Annual Conservation Plan ("ACP") in Docket No. UE-152058 on November 14, 2016. PSE also made minor updates to its Exhibit 3: Program Details in the second quarter. Adhering to its continuous adaptive management process, PSE improved its formatting, added clarifying language, and updated its customer offerings in the Exhibits.

The filing of these revisions is consistent with Condition (5) in Appendix A of Order 01 in Docket No. UE-152058, which indicates that program detail revisions must be filed as updates to the Biennial Conservation Plan ("BCP") with the Commission. In compliance with WAC 480-109-110(3), PSE provided its Conservation Resource Advisory Group ("CRAG") with an advance, "mark-up" copy of the documents on July 14, 2017.

## **Exhibit 3: Program Details**

Notable enhancements in Version Thirteen include:

- PSE updated references to its Multifamily Retrofit program. Formerly referenced as the Multifamily Existing program, this nomenclature was confusing to customers, and the update aligns with PSE's program collateral.
- Updated initiative implementation date references in the Direct to Consumer channel discussions, and
- Added an introductory discussion on PSE's Customer Connected Solar organization. This
  new nomenclature clarifies PSE's renewables program offerings for customers: Net
  Metering and the Renewable Energy Advantage Program (REAP).

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## Exhibit 4: Measures, Incentives & Eligibility

Exhibit 4's Twentieth Version includes updates to:

- two retail electric measure incentives,
- several multifamily retrofit electric measure incentives and product descriptions, and
- the addition of the Customer Connected Solar introductory language noted in Exhibit 3.

All program revisions are consistent with PSE's adaptive Total Quality Management principles.
