## NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND TO MOTION FOR THIRD-PARTY DISCOVERY

## TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 22, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission), on its own motion, and through its staff (Staff) issued a complaint against CenturyLink Communications, LLC (CenturyLink or Company) in Docket UT-181051 regarding interruptions in 911 service on December 27, 2018. The Commission convened a prehearing conference on February 9, 2021, and on February 24, entered Order 01, Prehearing Conference Order; Notice of Hearing (Order 01). Order 01, among other things, established a procedural schedule for this adjudication and established that discovery would be conducted to the Commission's rules, Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-07-400-425.

On July 9, 2021, CenturyLink filed a Motion for Third-Party Discovery (Motion), requesting that the Commission issue subpoenas to TeleCommunication Systems, Inc. d/b/a Comtech Telecommunications Corp. and Transaction Network Services, Inc. per WAC 480-07-400(2)(a).

Any party that opposes a written motion may file a written response within five business days after the motion is served.<sup>2</sup> The Commission received CenturyLink's motion on July 13, 2021, and thus calculates the response period from that date. Accordingly, parties may file a written response to the Motion by Tuesday, July 20, 2021.
