Pursuant to Order 2, paragraph 28 in Dockets UE-180607 and UG-180608, Puget Sound Energy (PSE or Company) filed its Final 2021 Integrated Resource Plan for electricity and natural gas service (Final IRP). Per <u>WAC 480-100-605</u>, an "integrated resource plan" means an analysis describing the mix of generating resources, conservation, methods, technologies, and resources to integrate renewable resources and, where applicable, address overgeneration events, and efficiency resources that will meet current and projected needs at the lowest reasonable cost to the utility and its ratepayers and that complies with the requirements specified in <u>RCW</u> 19.280.030(1).
