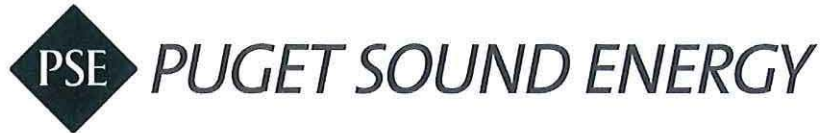

On December 15, 2016, PSE's Energy Management Committee authorized execution of the Skookumchuck Wind Project Power Purchase Agreement, conditioned upon 25 aMWs of customer commitments by binding agreement. The Green Direct team has enrolled customers in excess of the EMC threshold and now requests your signature to effectuate the agreement.

The PPA commits PSE to purchase the output from the project for 20 years from the COD, anticipated in December, 2018, with an additional five year option. Terms and conditions presented to the EMC in December remain materially intact.

On September 20, 2018, PSE's Energy Management Committee (EMC) authorized execution of the Lund Hill Solar Project Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) for 150 MW. Execution of the Lund Hill PPA meets current customer demand for the Green Direct Program, with a limited expansion from 75 aMW to 85 aMW. This limited expansion was approved by the EMC in September, and by the Washington Utilities & Transportation Commission (UTC) on October 19, 2018.

The PPA commits PSE to purchase the output from the project for 20 years from the COD, anticipated in December, 2020. Terms and conditions presented to the EMC in September remain materially intact.

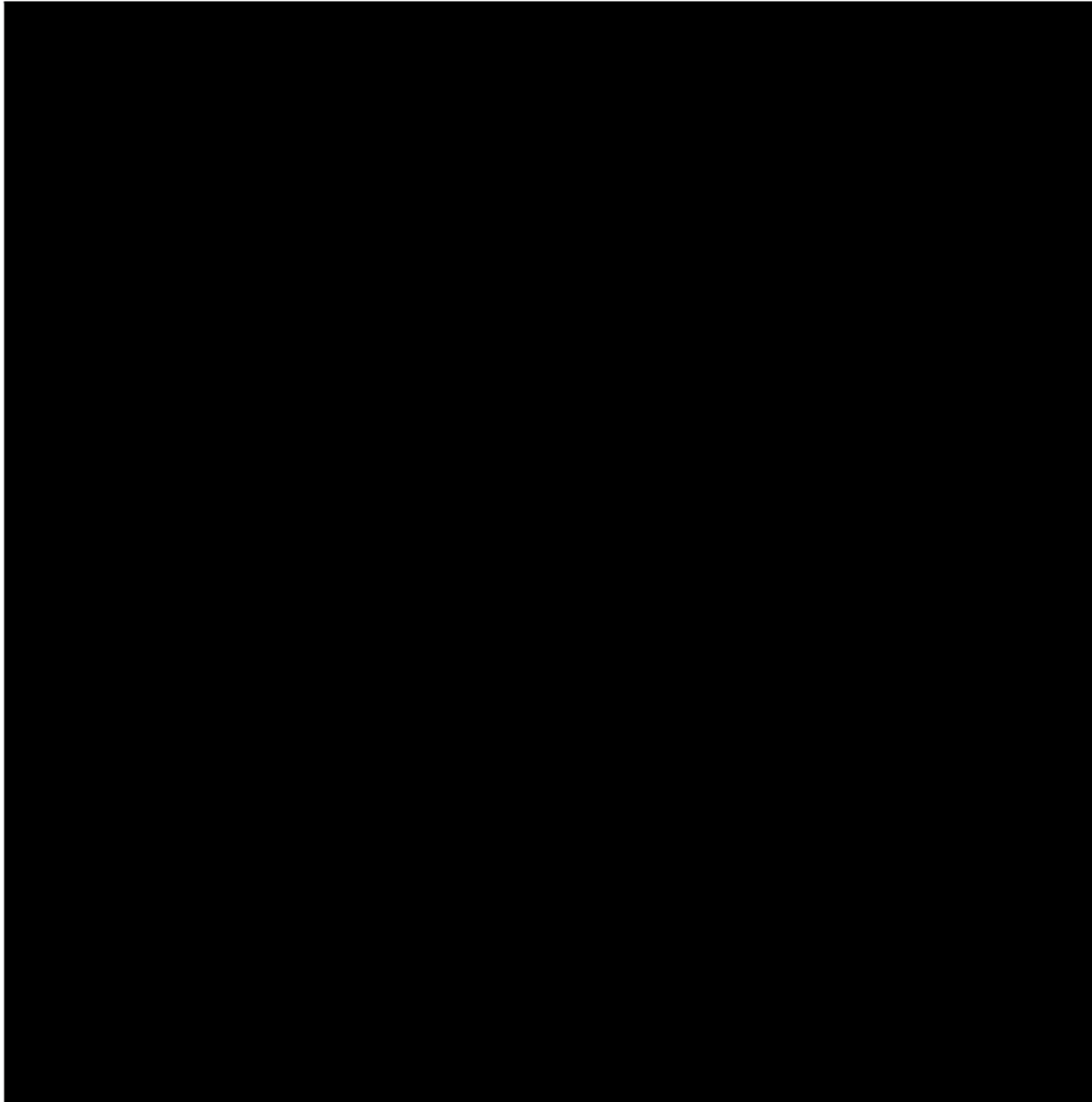


