Please vote yes to approve Puget Sound Energy's filing to extend current net-metering rates to new customers through December 31, 2025.

Net Metering is critical for the future of solar power in the PNW. With the long summer days, most of our solar generation occurs in the summer months - where individual homes can easily generate more power than they consume. Net metering provides a means of saving the excess summer generation for the short long dark days in the winter, when most of us cannot possibly generate enough power for our daily needs. Net Metering makes small solar facility economically feasible for homeowners.
