The proposed rules would implement requirements under the Governor's Executive Order 97-02, and would eliminate obsolete rules, reduce preparation time by the applicant and the Commission, express the rules in a clear and concise manner and would allow for new technology that is more efficient and effective. Among other improvements, the proposal would streamline the filing process for applications for registration, petitions for competitive classification, and initial price lists, and allow for electronic filings. In addition, the proposal would substantially reduce the requirements to offer prepaid calling services.
