Dear Mr. Johnson:

On December 28, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Order Approving Application Subject to Conditions in the above-referenced docket. Order 01, among other things, required HoldCo to notify the Commission within 90 days after it acquires or creates a new subsidiary.¹

On October 4, 2019, and November 8, 2019, HoldCo formed three new subsidiaries. On December 31, 2019, Northwest Natural Gas Company (NW Natural), on behalf of HoldCo, submitted a Statement of New Subsidiary.

Commission Staff reviewed the compliance filing provided by NW Natural dated December 31, 2019, and finds that it complies with the Commission's Order 01, entered December 28, 2017.

¹40. Within 90 days after HoldCo acquires or creates a new subsidiary entity, HoldCo shall file with the Commission a statement that provides the name of the subsidiary, the total value of its assets, the nature of the subsidiary's business and whether it will do business with NWN-U.
