¹ As stated in PSE's Response to WUTC Staff Data Request No. 269, there are certain transactions in the Gas Works Park and Tacoma Tar Pits deferral accounts that appear to have come from legacy accounting systems of PSE's predecessors and as such, detail for these transactions which occurred more than 19 years ago, is not readily available. Therefore, it is not possible at this time to determine whether any of the originating transactions exceed \$250,000. As PSE is able to obtain the detail for these transactions, it will be provided in a supplemental response to this data request.
