NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND TO JOINT CLECS' MOTION

**(Responses due by Tuesday, May 25, 2004)
(Replies due by Noon on Friday, June 4, 2004)**

RE: *In the Matter of the Petition of Qwest Corporation to Initiate a Mass-Market Switching and Dedicated Transport Case Pursuant to the Triennial Review Order, Docket No. UT-033044.*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On May 11, 2004, Advanced TelCom, Inc., d/b/a Advanced TelCom Group, Eschelon Telecom of Washington, Inc., Global Crossing Local Services, Inc., Integra Telecom of Washington, Inc., MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC and MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc., Pac-West Telecomm, Inc., Time Warner Telecom of Washington, LLC, and XO Washington, Inc. (collectively "Joint CLECs"), filed with the Commission a motion seeking an order from the Commission requiring Qwest to maintain the status quo of its obligations under existing Commission-approved interconnection agreements until resolution of the legal issues raised in the judicial review of the Federal Communications Commission's Triennial Review Order.

In order to resolve this matter prior to June 15, 2004, the day the D.C. Circuit's stay of its mandate will expire, any party who seeks to respond to the Joint CLECs' motion must do so in writing by Tuesday, May 25, 2004. Any party who seeks to file a reply must do so by Noon on Friday, June 4, 2004. Given the shortened time for responses, parties may submit responses with the Commission electronically or via facsimile pursuant to WAC 480-07-145(6) and file a paper copy with the Commission by the next business day.
